**Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 2017 in respect of your Daitari Iron Mine over an area of 1018.3085 hectare in Keonjhar district of Odisha.**

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above said mine during inspection on 27.08.2018 by the undersigned accompanied by You, and Shri B.B.Nayak, Manager of your mine.

Rule No.	Proposed in the approved mining plan / Rule	Violation
11 (1)	As per the approved mining scheme dated 22/03/2016, i) It is proposed to drill 58 nos & 80 nos of boreholes for exploration during the years 2016-17 and 2017-18. ii) It is proposed to construct 7 nos check dams during the year 2017-18 in the locations as shown in environment management plan.	i) During inspection it is observed that that no exploration work carried out during the year 2016-17 & 2017-18. ii) During inspection it was observed that check dams were not constructed as proposed during the year 2017-18.
31 (4)	The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date with in three months in case of category 'A' mines.	During inspection it is observed that surface plan was not updated within three months. The last updated plan was till 31.03.2018.

**02.** It is brought to your notice that these violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.

*Besides, inability to comply with the provision of Rule 11 (1) is liable for suspension of mining operations according to the provisions of Rule 11 (2) of MCDR, 2017.*

**03.** You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within **45 (forty-five) days** from the date of issue of this letter.
