Sub: Violation of Provisions of MCDR, 2017 in respect of your Kumbazary manganese mine over an extent of 25.65 Ha situated in Sy. No. 5,6, 60/P and 61 of Kumbazary Village, Adilabad District, Telangana State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017, were found violated in your above mine during the inspection of the mine on 17.04.2019 by the undersigned and accompanied by your good selves and Shri. V K Misar, Qualified person.

Rule no.	Nature of violation
11(1)	<p><i>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5.</i></p> <p>Mining operations are not carried out in accordance with the proposals given in approved Scheme of Mining vide letter no. AP/ADB/MP/Mn-26/Hyd dated 27.04.2018 to the extent indicated below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. It was approved to drill 35 no. of bore holes for the year 2018-19; against which no bore holes were drilled.2. It was approved to carry out mining operations by manual means by maintain bench height of 1.5 meters; against which mining operations were reported to be carried out by deploying machines i.e. Back Hoe-Loader, by maintaining bench height of more than 3 meters.3. It was approved to develop Pit 1 to an extent of 110m x 21 m x 3.2 meters to produce 7614 MT of ore by merging pit-1, pit-2 and Pit-3; against which new Pit has been developed to an extent of 140m x 10m x 4.5 m but produced manganese ore of 440 MT only which is on lower side than the approved proposals.4. It was approved to dump waste generated away from the pit on southern side between

	ML pillars 'L' and 'M' against which waste generated is used for backfilling and dumped adjacent to pit.
14 (1) & (3)	<p><i>The overburden and waste material obtained during mining operations shall not be allowed to be mixed with the materials of all the non-saleable or un-usable minerals or ores above the threshold value of the mineral, as may be notified by Indian Bureau of Mines from time to time shall be stacked separately on the ground earmarked for the purpose.</i></p> <p>During inspection of mines it was observed that ore is found dumped in the waste dump yard and no stock of low grade ore is maintained in the mines thus defeats the vary purpose of mineral conservation.</p>
27(4)	<p><i>The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (b) of sub-rule (1) of rule 42, and within twelve months in the case of any other mine.</i></p> <p>During inspection it was observed that plans and sections maintained were not updated as per the actual field condition. Location of pits, backfilled area, waste dump has not been demarcated as per field condition.</p>
45(7) (a)	<p><i>If it is found that the holder of a mining lease or the person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, as the case may be, has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in daily or monthly or annual returns or fails to submit a return within the date specified; then,–</i></p> <p><i>(a) in the case of mining of minerals by the holder of a mining lease, the Regional Controller of Mines may advise the State Government to, -</i></p> <p><i>(i) order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and to revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance;</i></p> <p><i>(ii) take action to initiate prosecution under these rules;</i></p> <p><i>(iii) recommend termination of the mining lease, in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining;</i></p> <p>On scrutiny of monthly return submitted for the month of November 2018, December 2018, January 2019, February 2019, the following discrepancies are observed</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Refer Part-II, item no.1, Production reported as Nil for the months of November 2018, December 2018, January 2019, February 2019, but on verification of documents during inspection of mines and documents submitted to this office vide your letter referred above wherein production of Manganese ore of 45 MT, 30 MT, 160 MT and 205 MT had been carried out for the months of November 2018, December 2018, January 2019, February 2019 respectively. 2. As per field observation pit has developed to an extent of 140m x 10m x 4.5 m but reported production of 440 tonnes only which is on lower side considering the recovery of ore as per the earlier approved document.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
