Sub :- Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Munsar Mine, over an extent of 25.15. Situated in Chargaon-village, Teh-Ramtek, and Nagpur District of Maharashtra State.

Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 18/06/2021(F/N), by Shri Kalmata. M.K, Regional Mining Geologist, in presence of Shri .U.M.Bhujade., Mines Manager.

Rule	Nature of Violation observed
11(1)	<p>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016. The following deviations were observed in the approved Review of Mining Plan dated 05.06.2017.</p> <p>a) In the approved Review of Mining plan dated 05.06.2017; there was a proposal to produce 200 T of Clean Ore in the year 2018-19 and 200T in the year 2020-21. However during inspection it was observed that no such production was carried out by the lessee and deviation is minus 100 percent.</p> <p>If the mining operations are not carried out in accordance with the approved or certified mining plan or any information contained in the mining plan is found to be incorrect, misleading or non-compliant with applicable laws including these rules, the competent</p>


	authority may by order, suspend all or any of the mining operations and permit continuance of only such operations as are required to restore the conditions in the mine as envisaged under the approved or certified mining plan or modified mining plan, for the purpose of restoration to the extent possible.
45 (7)	<p>Following deficiencies were observed in the annual returns submitted for the year 2019-20.</p> <p>a) As per the approved document area under mining is shown as 1.166Ha, but in the annual returns submitted for the year 2019-20, area under mining is shown as 0. Further details of existing dumps (active and inactive) for mineral and waste dumps are not given in the point no-12 of Part-I.</p> <p>b) Under Capital structure Value of fixed assets is shown as zero.</p>

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence, punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under Rule 11(2), if compliance of MCD Rules 2017 is not found satisfactory, or prosecution can be made, or both can be done.

04. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Fourty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
