Subject: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 2017, in respect of your Larung Limestone Mine (38MEG03012) over an area of 4.76 Ha. in Wahiajer Village, PO – Elaka Narpuh, East Jaintia Hills district of Meghalaya State.

Sir,

On perusal of office record, the following provision of MCDR, 2017 has been found violated in your above mine.

Rule Number	Nature of violations observed
45(6) : Any person or company engaged in trading or storage or end use or export of minerals , shall submit online to the Indian Bureau of Mines and concerned State Government , where the said person or company is sourcing the minerals, the returns in electronic form, along with the print copy of the same if this not digitally signed, in the following manner, namely (a) A monthly return which shall be submitted before the 10 th day of every month in respect of the preceding month in Form- L of the schedule ; (b) An annual return which shall be submitted before the first day of July of each year for the preceding financial year in Form - M of the schedule	<i>You have not submitted till date the monthly return and annual return for financial year 2018-19 and 2019-20 to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines, Guwahati.</i>

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.

03. If the above rules are not complied; The Regional Controller of Mines may advise to State Government to take following action under rule 45(7) (a):

(i) Order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and to revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance;

(ii) Take action to initiate prosecution under these rules;

(iii) Recommend termination of the mining lease, in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining;

04. You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offences.
05. Please note that no further notice will be given in this regard.
