
Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during Checkup inspection on 19/08/2021 by the undersigned in presence of Mr. S K Sinha - Head & Agent Mines, Mr. Santosh Singh - Mines manager & Engineer.

Rule 11 (1)	<p>According to this rule-No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Govt. pursuant to the provisions to clause (b) of Sub Section (2) of Section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for exploration and Researching respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule of the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limit declared under schedule-A of the Atomic Mineral Concession Rules 2016.</p> <p>The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No.MP/SIDHI/LST/RMP-26/2020-21 dated 24.12.2020 incorporating the proposals for 2020-21. During the inspection it was found that following provisions of rule have been violated</p> <p>In case of Review of Mining Plan approved for 5 years wef 2021-22 mentioned with 625000m3 ROM resulting to 1000000 Tons for every year. clarification is to be made for the 5 years proposal.</p>
Rule 54(c)	<p>Copies of notices and returns and reports to be maintained.-The holder of a mining lease or a holder of a prospecting licence or prospecting license-cum-mining lease shall maintain the labour attendance register, production and dispatch register, royalty assessment register,-</p> <p>(d) details of mining machinery and copies of all notices and returns, plans, sections and schemes submitted to the authorized officer or the State Government or the Regional Controller under these rules</p> <p>Mining Machinery Log book/Report not maintained.</p>

01. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.
02. Non-compliance of the rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 may lead to suspension of Mining operations under the provisions of rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017.
- 03 You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.




