Subject: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 2017, in respect of your Mynkree Limestone Mine (38MEG03014) over an area of 4.00 Ha. in village Mynkree Village, Taluka-Khliehriat, East Jaintia Hills district of Meghalaya State.

Sir,

On perusal of office record below mentioned rule of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 found violated in your above mine.

Rule Number	Nature of violations observed
11(4): The holder of a mining lease shall submit the mining plan to the competent authority for review at least 180 days before the expiry of 5 years period for which it was approved on the last occasion, for mining operations for a period of 5 subsequent years.	<p>The existing review of mining plan in respect of your Larung limestone mine over an extent of 4.76 Ha. in East Jaintia Hills district of Meghalaya is valid upto 31.3.2020 and the next review was due for submission on 02.10.19.</p> <p><i>You have submitted the draft copy of review of mining plan on 17.12.2019 to this office for its approval. The submitted document was approved conditionally by this office vide letter dated 23.01.2020 for compliance of the condition within one month from the date of issue of the approval letter.</i></p> <p><i>On perusal of your letter vide letter dtd. 20.02.202, the condition of the approval letter has not been complied and accordingly the approved review of mining plan was revoked vide letter dtd. 24.02.2020.</i></p> <p><i>Therefore the violation of provision under Rule 11(4) of MCDR 2017 stands valid as on date.</i></p>

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.

04. You are therefore directed to show cause within a period of 30 (Thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as why you should not be prosecuted for the above offences.

5. Please note no further notice will be give to you in this regard.
