Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Muddapur Limestone & Dolomite Mine (M.L.No.2589) over an extent of 4.86 Ha. situated in Muddapur Village, Mudhol Taluka, Bagalkot District of Karnataka State.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 23.12.2021 by Shri. Vidyadhar V. Tari, Asstt. Mining Engineer of this office in presence of yourself.

Rule No.	Nature of Violation observed
11(1)	The mining operations required to be carried out in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines. However mining operations have not been carried out in accordance with the Review & Updation of Mining Plan approved vide this office letter no. RMP/MAN-02(KNT)/GOA/2017-18 dated 25.01.2018 to the extent indicated below:- (i) During 2020-21, it was proposed to produce 51,132 tonnes of Limestone. However, production of only 14678.10 tonnes of Limestone has been reported, which is only about 29% of

	<p>the proposed production.</p> <p>(ii) During 2020-21, it was proposed to plant 100 sapplings. However, it is reported that only 50 trees have been planted with survival rate of 60%</p>
55(1)(c)(ii)	A Part-time Mining Engineer and Geologist required to be employed under this rule has not been employed in the mine.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
03. The mining operations can be suspended under Rule 11(2) of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017 if compliance of Rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
04. You are, therefore, advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
