Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Ravirala limestone Mine over (60.72 ha) situated in Ravirala village of Jaggayyapeta mandal in Krishna district of Andhra Pradesh state.

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 (MCDR, 1988), were found violated in your above mine during the inspection of the mine on 23.04.2017 by the undersigned and accompanied by Sri B S P Raju, Agent, Sri Venkateshwara Reddy, Mines Manager and Sri B Raju, Geologist, of your mine.

45(7)	If it is found that the holder of a mining lease or the person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, as the case may be, has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in daily or monthly or annual returns or fails to submit a return within the date specified.	On scrutiny of Monthly returns submitted to this office for the year 2016-17, the following discrepancy was observed: Refer Part-I, item no.5, employment of contractual persons is furnished as Nil, whereas during field inspection it was observed that about 20 no. of contractual persons are employed in the mine

02. Further, please refer this office letters dated 05.12.2016, 16.01.2017 and 24.03.2017, wherein the violation of rule 11(1) of MCDR, 2017 (rule 13(1) of MCDR,1988), is still exist in your mine.
02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR, 2017, further other actions can be initiate as per the provision of rule 45(7)(a) of MCDR, 2017, if compliance of rules 45(7) is not found satisfactory.
03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
