Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Koromanipalle limestone Mine over (49.64 ha) situated in Korumanipalle village, Kolimigundla mandal in Kurnool district of Andhra Pradesh state.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017, was found violated in your above mine during the inspection of the mine on 17-3-2018 by Shri Y.M.Shiva Prasad Asistant Mining Engineer of this office and accompanied by Sri P.Rama Krishna Reddy ,Mines Manager of your mine.

11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5	Mining operations are not carried out in accordance with the proposals given in approved Scheme of Mining vide letter no. AP/KNL/MP/Lst-86/HYD dated 30.10.2015 to the extent indicated below: i. It was approved to carryout mining operations on northern side of the lease area in between N50- N300 & W300-E150 for development and production during the year 2017-18, against which it was observed during inspection that production and development is also being carried out in southern side of the lease area in addition to the Northern side. ii. Mining operations were being carried out within 7.5 meters of the lease area on southern side of the lease area without any such approved proposals. iii. Area degraded in the lease and that of the area proposed for considering FA is different and also more than the area approved in the mining plan.
26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1 st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons therof.	The yearly report for the year 2016-17 setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitation work carried out as envisaged in the approved scheme of Mining has not been submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines, Hyderabad.

31(4)	The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve	During inspection it was observed that plans and sections were not maintained updated.
	months in the case of any other mine.	
55(1)(a)	Every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of category 'A' mines, a Whole time Mining Engineer and a Geologist having minimum 5 years professional experience in field of mining.	But the said statutory staff has not been appointed to look after the job of Mining Engineer and Geologist as per rule.

- 02. It is to bring to your notice that the above violation constitute an offence punishable under Rule-62 of MCDR, 2017..
- 03. You are therefore, advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from date of issue of this letter.
