Sir,

The following provisions of the MCDR, 1988 were found violated in your above mine during the MCDR inspection by Sri A.S.Sanjeeva Rao, Asst., Mining Geologist on 06.3.2016 in presence of your representative Sri Muniyandi.

Rule No	Nature of Violations observed
16	The overburden and waste material obtained during mining operations shall not be allowed to be mixed with non-salable or subgrade minerals/ores. They shall be dumped and stacked separately on the ground earmarked for the purpose.
	But, on the day of inspection, it was observed that the limestone mineral is not segregated properly and mineral is not separated/dumped in lease area instead of stacking on the place earmarked for it.

- 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 58 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 1988.
- 03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
