Subject: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 2017, in respect of your South-Khliehjeri Limestone Mine (38MEG03004) over an area of 31.05 Ha. in Thangskai Village, Taluka-Khliehriat, East Jaintia Hills district of Meghalaya State.

Sir,

The following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection carried out on 24th August 2018 by the undersigned in presence of the mine officials Sri N. Narayan Reddy (Mines Manager) and Abdul Motin Barbhuiya (Geologist).

Nature of violations observed Rule Number 11(1): No holder of a mining lease shall commence The following deviations to the approved review or carry out mining operations in any area except of mining plan were found in your mine:in accordance with the mining plan approved, i) Protective Measures:- There was a proposal modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of given to construct retaining wall of 750m, 425m and garland drain of 300m around the Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government proposed temporary waste dump and soil dump respectively in the approved modification of pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent mining plan document; but till date there are no authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for retaining wall and garland drain around the temporary waste dump and soil dump. Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession. i) You have not submitted yearly report to the 26(2): The holder of mining lease shall submit to competent authority till date. the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof;

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- 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
- 03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
- 04. You are advised to rectify the violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within a period of 45 (Forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
