Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules,2017 in respect of your **Jarah-Mohgaon Mangnese Ore Mine (6.159 Hect.in Village – Jarah-Mohgaon, District-Balaghat, State-Madhya Pradesh.**

Dear Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the MCDR inspection by Shri Prashay Gajbhiye, Assistant Mining Engineer on 18.10.2021 in presence of Shri P.K.Bisen, & Shri Vikas Pandey Lessee Representative, under:-

Rule 11 (1)	<p>According to this rule-No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Govt. pursuant to the provisions to clause (b) of Sub Section (2) of Section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for exploration and Researching respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule of the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limit declared under schedule-A of the Atomic Mineral Concession Rules 2016.</p> <p>The Review of the approved of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No-MP/Balaghat/Manganese/RMP-33/2018-19 dated 20.12.2018. incorporating the proposals for 2020-21. During the inspection it was found that following provisions of rule have been violated.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) Development of the benches is found unsystematic.</li><li>2) Lower benches were submerged in the water and no sufficient Pumping arrangement were found for dewatering.</li><li>3) Retaining wall and Settling tank not constructed properly as per approved Proposal.</li></ol>
Rule 26(2)	<p>The holder of mining lease shall submit a yearly report as per the format specified before 1st July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative work carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reason thereof "Annual PMCP report not submitted for the reporting year (2020-21)".</p>
Rule (45) (5)	<p>The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner, namely:-</p> <p>c) an annual return which shall be submitted before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form, along with a signed print copy of the same if is not digitally signed, in the respective Form.</p> <p>"During inspection it is observed that you have not submitted annual return 2020-21".</p>

Rule 55	<p>Employment of geologists and mining engineers. -(1) For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules, -</p> <p>(a) every holder of reconnaissance permit shall employ a whole-time geologist;</p> <p>(b) every holder of prospecting licence or a prospecting license-cum-mining lease shall employ a whole-time geologist and a part-time mining engineer;</p> <p>(c) every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of-</p> <p>(i) category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist;</p> <p>(ii) category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist:</p> <p>Provided that in the case of fully mechanised category 'A' mines, the mining engineers and geologists shall have minimum five years of professional experience of working in a supervisory capacity in the field of mining:</p> <p>“Appointment of Mining Engineer &amp; Geologist has not been Submitted.”</p>

- 02) In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.
- 03) Non-compliance of the rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 may lead to suspension of Mining operations under the provisions of rule 11(2) .
- 04) You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
