Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Sunehra Limestone Mine, Minecode 38MPR47035 over an area of 4.20 hect. in Katni District of MP.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection in connection with submitted draft RMP on 19.08.2022 by Sh. Jay Kumar Pandey, Assistant Mining Engineer, accompanied by Sh. A.K. Shukla, Representative of lessee.

नियम स.	पाए गए उल्लंघन की विस्तृत प्रकृति
Rule 11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016. The document of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No.- MP/Katni/Limestone /MOD-62/2017-18 dated 07/11/2017 incorporating proposal of working from 2017-18 to 2021-22. (a) Exploration was not done against the proposal of 04 nos. of exploratory Core bore holes for the year 2017-18. (b) During 2021-22 the working is not done in proposed site. (c) During 2021-22 the soil/waste dumping is not done in proposed site.
Rule 26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1 st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof. Lessee has not submitted annual PMCP report for the reporting year (2021-22).
Rule 34A (3)	Digital aerial images of mining lease area.— Every lessee shall carry out a drone survey of his leased area and upto hundred metres outside the lease boundary within six months before submission of any mining plan document or modification thereto to the Indian Bureau of Mines for approval and shall submit processed output [digital elevation model (DEM) and Orthomosaic] images obtained from such survey or any other format as may be specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines in this regard to the concerned Regional Controller of Mines and the Controller General along with the application for approval or modification of mining plan. Drone Survey has not been carried out for the leased area and upto hundred metres outside the lease boundary and the processed output [digital elevation model (DEM) and Orthomosaic] images have not been submitted as specified in the rule.
Rule 45(5)(b)	The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorised official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner- A monthly return which shall be submitted before the tenth day of every month in respect of the preceding month in electronic form along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the respective form. But, during inspection & on the verification of records of this mine it was observed that, you have not submitted Monthly Returns online since beginning (only for July 2022 submitted online with nil production). Therefore, you are directed to submit aforesaid returns in online system immediately.
Rule 45(5)(c)	The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorised official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner- An annual return which shall be submitted before the 1 st day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form, along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the respective Form. But, during inspection & on the verification of records of this mine it was observed that, you have not submitted any online Annual Returns since beginning to this Regional office. Therefore, you are directed to submit aforesaid return in online system immediately.

Rule 55

For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules, –


- (a) every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of–
(i) category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist;
(ii) category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist:

Provided that in the case of fully mechanised category 'A' mines, the mining engineers and geologists shall have minimum five years of professional experience of working in a supervisory capacity in the field of mining.

The Mining Engineer & Geologist have not been appointed in the mine.

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
3. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
4. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.






