**Sub:** Violation of provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988, in respect of your Prospecting License for Limestone in Medesara village, over an extent of 29.20 hectares in Dhamdha tehsil, Durg district.

Sir,

The following provision of the MCDR, 1988 were found violated in your above Prospecting License.

Rule No.	Nature of Violations Observed
<b>Rule 8 (1) (b)</b>	<b>Report of prospecting operations :-</b> (1) Every holder of a prospecting licence shall submit to the Controller General, Controller of Mines and the Regional Controller: - (b) An yearly report in Form-B so as to reach them within thirty days after the expiry of 1[twelve months] from the date of execution of the prospecting licence or the expiry of the prospecting licence whichever is earlier. The same has not been submitted.

02. In this connection, it is to brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 58 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988.

03. You are advice to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
