Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 in respect of your Dighori Kyanite Mines over an area of 14.330 Hect. located in village Dighori (Mothi), District-Bhandara of Maharashtra state.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 were found violated in your abovementioned mine during the inspection by the above mine during the inspection on 07.06.2016 carried out by Shri. S.M.Dorle, Asistant Mining Engineer. This was communicated to you vide this office letter of even no. dated 29.06.2016 giving you 45 days time for rectification of the same.

Rule No. Nature of violation observed in details

The Scheme of mining along with Progressive Mine Closure Plan in respect of above mine was approved under rule 12 of MCDR 1988 vide this office letter No. BHD/KYA/715/MS-11, dt. 23.07.2012. The Scheme of mining shall be submitted to the Regional Controller of mines at least one hundred twenty days before the expiry of the five years period, but same has not yet been submitted for approval to the Regional Controller of Mines so far.

Thus this attracts violation of provision of Rule 12(3) of MCDR 1988.

From the office record it is also found the violation of the following:-

- The owner has not registered with the Indian Bureau of Mines as per application specified in Form M.
- 45(5) As per record the lease was granted in the name of Shri Pradeep Golchha, but name of the owner has been given in the annual return is M/s Dighori Kynite Mine.
- 45(7) If it is found that the owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of the mine has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in the monthly or special or annual return or fails to submit a return within the date specified, then the Regional Controller of Mines may,
 - a) order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and may revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance;
 - b) take action to initiate prosecution under these rules;
 - c) recommend termination of the mining lease in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining

- 03. You are, therefore, <u>directed to show-cause within a period of 30 days</u> from the date of issue of this letter, as to why mining operations in your above mine should not be suspended in accordance to rule 45(7) of MCDR, 1988 and the lease is recommended for termination as well as prosecution of the owner, agent and manager.
- 04. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
