Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 2017 in respect of Parambaljori Iron ore & Manganese Mine lease of M/s Anindita Steels Ltd. over an area of 47.15 hect, Singhbhum (West) district, Jharkhand state.

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017(MCDR, 2017) were found violated in the above mine during inspection on 12/03/2021 by the undersigned in presence of Shri K.P.Singh, G.M.& Sri Chittaranjan Mahakud, Mines Manager, Sri Ashutosh Mahapatra, Sr. Geologist & Sri Abhas Kr.Rout, Mining Engineer.

Rule No. Nature of Violation in detail

Rule 11(1): No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines. The mining operations are not carried out as per approved Review of Mining Plan approved vide letter no. RAN/WSB/Fe-Mn/MP-01/2020-21 dated 12/10/2020 to the extent indicated as follows:-

- A. As per condition no. (viii) of the approval letter for approved Review of Mining Plan along with progressive mine closure plan, dated 12/10/2020, Environmental Daily monitoring report have not been displayed on display board near mine/mine office.
- 02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence punishable under Rule-62 of MCDR-2017. The relevant extract of the rule 62 is given below:
 - "62 Penalty: -Whoever contravenes any of the provisions of these rules shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or with fine which may extend to five lakh rupees, or with both, and in the case of a continuing contravention, with additional fine which may extend to fifty thousand rupees for every day during which such contravention continues after conviction for the first such contravention.
- 03. You are, therefore, advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45(forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
