Sub: - Violation of the provisions of MCDR, 2017 in respect of your Jamunanagar Limestone mine (38ASM08002) over an area of 35 ha. in Dima Hasao Dist . of Assam state.

(2) Your email dtd. 17.9.2020, enclosing shp files of the land use data of the aforesaid ML.

Sir,

On perusal of this office record, following provisions of MCDR 2017 have been found violated in your above mine -

Rule No.	Nature of violation observed
33 – The holder of the mining lease shall on or before 30th day of June every year submit to the authorized officer as the case may be and the State Govt. a digital copy alongwith the print copy of the surface geological plans & sections maintained under rule 32.	A copy of the updated surface plan was submitted by you vide your aforesaid letter under reference No. 1 which was updated as on 31.3.2020.  The land use data of the aforesaid mine in shp file format was submitted on 6.9.2020 & again on 7.9.2020 against this office email enclosing letter No. IBM/GHY/153/2017/TECH/MTS dtd. 3.9.2020. Further, the final land use data of the aforesaid mine in shp file format
	On perusal of the above information, it is clearly observed that the dumps have been advanced towards the south east side of the existing mining lease but the same has not been shown in the surface plan submitted to this office on 27.6.2020.

- 02 In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR 2017.
- The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not 03 found satisfactory.
- You are therefore directed to show cause within a period of 30 (Thirty) days from the date of 04 issue of this letter, as why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence.
- Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard. 05
