Violation cum Showcause letter

To, Shri Nikhil Mittal, (Nominated Owner) M/s. Hills Cement Company Limited, Village – Mynkree, Dist-East Jaintia Hills, Meghalaya - 793210 E-Mail: mineshccl@gmail.com

Sub: - Violation of the provisions of MCDR, 2017, in respect of your Mynkree Limestone mine (38MEG03014) over an area of 4.00 Ha. in Mynkree Village, Taluka - Khliehrat, East Jaintia Hills district of Meghalaya state.

On perusal of this office record, following provisions of MCDR, 2017, have been found violated in your above mine -

Rule No.

11(1): No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of the minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the Grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Mineral Concession Rules, 2016.

Nature of violation observed

A copy of the last updated surface plan as on 13.03.2020 was submitted by you along with the last approved review of mining plan.

The land use data of the aforesaid mine in kmlfile format was submitted on 17.9.2020 against this office email enclosing letter No. IBM/GHY/153/2017/TECH/MTS dtd. 3.9.2020.

On perusal of the above information, it is clearly observed that the mine benches have been advanced towards south-west side of the mining lease which is not as per the approved review of mining plan.

- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR 2017.
- The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not 03 found satisfactory.
- You are therefore directed to show cause within a period of 30 (Thirty) days from the date of 04 issue of this letter, as why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence.
- Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard. 05
