Sir,

On perusal of office record, the following provision of MCDR 2017 was violated in your above mine.

satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map, as	
on the 31st day of March for that financial year, covering	
the mining lease and an area of two kilometres from the	
lease boundary, to the Regional Controller or the	
authorized officer of the Indian Bureau of Mines.	

- 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
- 03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
- 04. You are advised to rectify the violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within a period of 45 (Forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
