Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 in respect of Nagarur Limestone mine over an area of 4.202 ha in Sy.No.263 A,B,D, E & 264 situated in Nagarur Village Yadiki (M), Anantapur district of A.P state

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017, was found violated in the above mine during the inspection on 06.9.2017 by Shri Y.M Siva Prasad, Assistant Mining Engineer., of this office accompanied by Shri Balaram, Mines Manager.

11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the Mining Plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines.	Mining operations are not being carried out in accordance with the proposals given in approved Review of Mining Plan vide this office letter No.AP/ANP/LST-42/Hyd dated 20.9.2016 to the extent indicated below : It was approved to carry out exploration by 04 nos DTH and one core bore hole for the year 2016-17, against which no exploration was carried out so far.
26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1 st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof.	The yearly report for the year 2016-17 setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitation work carried out as envisaged in the approved Review of Mining has not been submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines, Hyderabad.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR, 2017. Besides, inability to comply the provision of Rule 11(1) is also liable for suspension of mining operations under rule 11(2) of MCDR, 2017

03. You are therefore ,advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from date of issue of this letter
