

Violation of provisions of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your sukli Manganese ore Mine (79.55 Hect.) in Balaghat district of M.P. State.

Dear Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during Stoping inspection/MCDR inspection on 17/01/2020 by the undersigned in presence of Mr. Manoj singh, Mines Manager.

Rule.	Nature of violations observed .
Rule 55 of MCDR 2017	Employment of geologists and mining engineers(1) For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules,— 1. every holder of reconnaissance permit shall employ a whole-time geologist; 2. every holder of prospecting licence or a prospecting license cum mining lease shall employ a whole-time geologist and a part-time mining engineer; 3. every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of— (iii) category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist; (iv) category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist: The appointment of mining engineer and geologist is not submitted in required form H for
	the mine. (2) The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the
Rule 26(2) MCDR 2017	(2) The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority of the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof:
	Statement for progressive closure in this rule is not submitted.
Rule 45 MCDR 2017	If it is found that the holder of a mining lease or the person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, as the case may be, has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in daily or monthly or annual returns or fails to submit a return within the date specified;
	then,— Provided that the holder of a mining lease or the person of company engaged in trading of storage or end user or export of minerals, as the case may be, referred to in clause (a), (b) and (c) above, shall be informed in writing about the violation and if the violation is not rectified within a period of forty-five days, a show cause notice shall be given asking reasons why the mining operations should not be suspended and, further, if no satisfactory reply is received within a period of thirty days, the mining operations may be suspended. (1.The appointment of geologist is part time.(full time geologist is required). 2. information on fixed assets is not give. 3. details of mining machinery used for excavation etc is not given.

02.In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offer under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.

03 . You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
