**Scrutiny comments on examination of Mining Plan of Gorlagutta Limestone Block over an area of 181.03 hectares in Gorlagutta Village, Bethamcharla Mandal, Kurnool District, Andhra Pradesh submitted under Rule 16 (1) of MCR 2016.**

**General**

1. Mining Block name shall be mentioned correctly in the cover page.
2. The limestone requirement for the present plant capacity was submitted as 3.2 million tonnes per annum and mining plan of feeding mines have already been approved for 3.6 million tonnes. Justify the reason as why the mining plan be approved for 0.8 million tonnes per annum from this mine.
3. The final document shall adhere the conditions stipulated in CCOM circular No. 01/2021 dated 07.06.2021 & FAQ on format of Mining Plans issued vide CCOM Circular 1/2021 dated 08.09.2021.
4. During inspection it was found that the boundary pillars are not installed/erected in the lease area.

**Chapter 1: General Information**

**1.1. Lease details**

- a). IBM registration number shall be mentioned correctly.
- b). Taluk/Mandal name shall be mentioned correctly.

**1.2. Land ownership details**

Details to be submitted for all Khasra Nos. separately.

**1.3.4. Statutory Compliances**

Statutory clearance details shall be submitted correctly.

**1.3.5. Mine Location Details**

Toposheet number details shall be submitted.

Boundary pillar co-ordinates shall be submitted in UTM co-ordinates as annexure.

**1.3.6. Owner/Nominated Details**

As mentioned in the Mining Plan format, minutes of Board Resolution in case of Nominated owner shall be submitted.

**Chapter 2: Geology & Exploration**

**2.1.2.** Details of the physiographic features and infrastructures available in and around the lease/block area shall be submitted correctly.

**2.1.4.3.** Average thickness & grade of the various types of limestone in the lithology units shall be submitted.

**2.2.1.1.** Geological mapping details shall be submitted correctly.

**2.2.1.9.** Sampling details shall be submitted correctly.

**2.2.1.10.** Chemical analysis details shall be submitted correctly.

**2.2.5.5.** As per rule 12(3) of MCDR 2017, the holder of mining block shall carry out detailed exploration (G1 level) over the entire potentially mineralized area under the mining lease, within a period of five years from the date of opening of the mine after execution of such mining block. Exploration proposal and commitment to complete the exploration shall be submitted accordingly.

Exploration shall be proposed and carried out for the entire mineralized area up to discontinuance of ore body under the mining lease.

## **Chapter 4: Mining Operations**

4.1.2. Proposed method of mining shall be submitted correctly.

4.2.1.2. Dump status shall be submitted correctly.

4.2.2.2. Development and production proposal shall be submitted from 1<sup>st</sup> year onwards since cement grade limestone is available as outcrops in some areas of the mining block.

4.2.2.3. Transportation & hauling equipment proposed to use in the mine shall be submitted correctly.

4.3.1. a). Blast vibration study may be proposed for maintaining the safe charge/delay to protect damage of structures/buildings in the nearby villages of the mining block.

b). Slope stability study may be proposed and the recommendations made there under may be incorporated in the proposed workings.

4.3.2. Insitu mining shall be proposed for the mining plan period.

4.3.4. Calculation summary table shall be submitted correctly after including ROM quantity from insitu mining.

4.7. Waste management details shall be submitted correctly in the relevant headings.

5.2. Proposal shall be submitted for CSR initiatives during the mining plan period.

## **Chapter 6: Progressive Mine Closure Plan**

6.2.2.2. Proposals for protective measures like retaining wall and garland drains shall be submitted.

Surface plan is not updated and last survey carried out is not mentioned. The surface features, old mining benches, mineral stack and waste dump are not matching with surface plan submitted. Updated plans and sections shall be submitted.
