Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 (MCDR,1988) in respect of your Emboy Limestone Mine over an extent of 16.253 ha in Emboy Village, Veldurty Mandal, Kurnool District of Andhra Pradesh.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 16.9.2016 by Smt. Ch.Suseela, Assistant Mining Geologist of this office accompanied by your Son Shri, I. Chandrasekhar.

The Scheme of Mining was approved vide this office letter dated 03.04.2013 having approved proposals valid up to 31.03.2016. At present, there are no valid approved proposals in the form of scheme of mining to carryout mining operations for your above mentioned mine in turn construed as mining operations are not being carried out in accordance with the approved mining plan/ Scheme of Mining.
23 E(2)	The owner, agent, manager or mining engineer shall submit to the Regional Controller of Mines or the officer authorised by the State Government in this behalf, as the case may be, a yearly report before 1st July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof.	The yearly report for the year 2015-16 setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitation work carried out as envisaged in the approved scheme of Mining has not been submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines, Hyderabad.
27	The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (b) of sub-rule (1) of rule 42, and within twelve months in the case of any other mine.	During inspection it was observed that plans and sections required under these rules have not been maintained updated.

- 02. It is brought to your notice that the above said violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule-58 of MCDR, 1988. Besides, inability to comply the provision of Rule 13(1) is also liable for suspension of mining operations under Rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988.
- O3. You are, therefore, directed to **show-cause** within a period of 30(thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be **prosecuted** for the above offence and or Mining operations shall be suspended under the provision of Rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988 in the Mine till the compliance of the aforesaid violation.
- 04. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
