Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 22.09.2021 by undersigned along with Shri K. Srinivas, AMG in presence of Shri Brijesh Kumar, Mines Manager, Shri Nataraj B.D, Dy.Manager(Geology), Shri Rakesh A.S, Mining Engineer and other mine officials:

Rules	Nature of Violations observed
11 (1)	Modified Mining plan was approved by IBM vide letter no. 279/1089/2017/BNG/12 dated 02/06/2020, for the period 2020-21 to 2022-23. The deviations observed in mining operation vis-à-vis approved document are given below. i) During the year 2020-21, exploratory drilling of 8 boreholes has been proposed, whereas no drilling has been carried out. ii) It was observed during site inspection that against the proposed production of 4,08,000 tonnes, the actual production is reported as 2,07,380 tonnes during the year 2020-21. The deviation is almost 50%. iii) The proposed waste handling is 86238 tonnes under development for the year 2020-21, whereas only 1620 tonnes of waste has been handled. The deviation is more than 95%.

45(7)	<p>The online Annual return for the year 2020-21 has been submitted by the Lessee; Following discrepancies are noted in the submitted copy as observed during site inspection.</p> <p><u>Part-II</u> : The number of days mine worked is given as 311days. As per the submitted Form-E and Form-C, the number of days mine worked is not given correctly.</p> <p><u>Part-VI</u>: The Ex-mine price reported in Part-VI (3) has not been reported correctly. In case of Captive mines, the Ex-mine price per tonne is the per unit cost of production.</p>
