Sub: Violation of the provisions of MCDR, 2017 in respect of your Dillai Parbat Limestone Mine (38ASM06001) over an area of 171.00 Ha. in Dillai Parbat Village, Taluka- Bokajan, Karbi Anglong district of Assam State.

Ref: 1. Your letter dated 23.5.2018 submitting updated copies of surface plan as on 27.3.2018.

- 3. Your email dated 16.10.2020, enclosing kml files of land uses of aforesaid ML.

Sir,

On perusal of this office record, following provisions of MCDR 2017 have been found violated in your above mine –

# Rule No. 11(1): No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of the minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the Grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Mineral Concession Rules, 2016.

# Nature of violation observed

A copy of the updated surface plan was submitted by you vide your aforesaid letter under reference no-1.

The land use data in kml file format was also submitted by you on 17.9.2020 against this office email enclosing letter No IBM/GHY/153/2017/TECH/MTS dated 3.9.2020 which was further re-submitted on 16.10.2020 to this office.

On perusal of above information, it is clearly observed that the dumps have advanced towards west side of mining lease along line CD which is not as per the approved review of mining plan.

- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
- The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
- You are therefore directed to show cause within a period of 30 (Thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence.
