Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development, 2017 in respect of your Venkatapuram Lime Stone Mine of Smt. S.Seethamma over an extent of 4.194 ha situated in Sy.No.83,85& 86/3 of Venkatapuram village, Banaganapalli Mandal, Kurnool District, Andhra Pradesh State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 (MCDR, 2017) were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 08.9.2017 by Shri Y.M.Shiva Prasad, Asst.Mining Engineer of this office, in the presence of Sri M.Narayana Reddy, representative of mine owner.

Scheme of Mining in respect of the subject mine was having proposal valid upto 31.3.2017. At present there is no approved proposal to carry out mining operation which inturn construed as not Mining operations are not being carried out in accordance with the proposals.
11(4)	The holder of mining lease shall submit the review of mining plan to the competent authority for review at least one hundred and eighty days before the expiry of five years period for which it was approved on the last occasion, for mining operations for a period of five subsequent years.	Scheme of Mining for the above mine was approved vide this office letter No. AP/KNL/MP/LST-81/HYD dated 21.03.2013 for a period of 2012-13 to 2016-17 having proposals valid upto 31.3.2017. The mining plan/RMP for subsequent period ought to have been submitted 180 (one hundred and eighty days) before the expiry on the last occasion, but the same has not been submitted so far to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines, Hyderabad.

Further during earlier inspection referred at Sl.No. (i) the violation of rule 11(1) was pointed out as below:

11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the Mining Plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines.	Mining operations are not being carried out in accordance with the proposals given in Scheme of Mining for the above mine which was approved vide this office letter No. AP/KNL/MP/LST-81/HYD dated 21.03.2013 for a period of 2012-13 to 2016-17 to the extent indicated below: It was approved to carry out exploration by 03 nos of bore holes during the year 2013-14, against which no exploration was carried out so far.

In reply vide your letter at Sl. No. (ii) you have submitted the proposal of exploration of 4 bore holes in Form-J, but the above bore holes were not carried out as observed during the present inspection. Thus, the violation of rule 11(1) is still continue in your mine.

- It is to bring to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence punishable under Rule-62 of MCDR, 2017. Besides, inability to comply the provisions of rule 11(1) is also liable for suspension of mining operations under provisions of rule 11(2) of MCDR 2017.
- You are therefore, advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from date of issue of this letter
