Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 1988 in respect of Gundlapally Limestone mine over an area of 130.42 ha in Gundlapally village, Mattampalli Mandal & Nalgonda District, Telangana State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 12.02.2016 by undersigned in the presence of Sri G S Subba Rao, Manager(Mines).

Rule No.	Nature of Violation
13(1)	Mining operations should have been undertaken in accordance with the approved Mining Plan/Scheme of mining. The Modified Mining plan was approved vide no. AP/NLG/MP/Lst-11-Hyd on 01.12.2015 for the period 2015-16 and 2019-20 and following deviations observed during the inspection. 1. In Para 1 of Part A(Exploration & Reserves) twenty six(26 nos) core boreholes has been proposed for the year 2015-16 but the core drilling was still not started and neither information for starting of drilling received by this office. 2. In Para 8.3.1, 1050 nos of saplings is proposed to be planted along 7.5 meter barrier zone in western side of ML ,but no such plantation done.
23 E(2)	The owner ,agent, manager or mining engineer shall submit to the Regional Controller of Mines, a yearly report before 1 st July of every year setting forth extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation ,reasons thereof. But the same not submitted in this office for 2014-15.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above said violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule-58 of MCDR, 1988. Besides, inability to comply the provision of Rules 13(1) is also liable for suspension of mining operations under the provision of Rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988.

03. You are, therefore, directed to **show-cause** within a period of 30(thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be **prosecuted** for the above offence and or Mining operations shall be suspended under the provision of Rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988 in the Mine till the compliance of the aforesaid violation.

04. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
