On perusal of the office records and above cited referenced letters, the following provision of MCDR, 2017 was found violated in your above mine.

11(1): No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A

of the Atomic Minerals Concession.

Nature of violations observed

The following deviations to the approved review of mining plan were found in your mine:-

You have submitted updated surface plan and section and environment plan along with your compliance letter vide dated 25.09.2020 in response to this office violation cum show-cause letter dated 22.09.2020. Further you have submitted land use data of your ML area in KML files vide e-mail dated 13.10.2020. On examination of the both the document, the dump area shown in the KML file coincides with the South-South Eastern ML boundary of the lease area, whereas the same has been shown about 60-80mtr away from the South-South Eastern ML boundary of the lease area in the updated surface plan and section, which is not as per the proposal of approved review of mining plan.

- 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
- 03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
- 04. You are therefore directed to show cause within a period of 30 (Thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as why you should not be prosecuted for the above offences.
- 5. Please note no further notice will be give to you in this regard.
