Sir,

On perusal of the office records the following provision of MCDR, 2017 was found violated in your above mine.


Rule Number	Nature of violatfons observed
11(4): The holder of a mining lease shall submit the mining plan to the competent authority for review at least 180 days before the expiry of 5 years period for which it was approved on the last occasion, for mining operations for a period of 5 subsequent years.	The existing review of mining plan in respect of your Jamunanagar Limestone Mine (38ASM08002) over an area of 35.00 Ha. in Jamunanagar Village, Taluka- Umrangshu, Dima Hasao district of Assam State is valid up-to 31.3.2021 and the next review was due for submission on 02.10.2020. <i>You have submitted draft copy of review of mining plan to this office for its approval vide letter dated 14.09.2020 but the same was dis-approved for the reason recorded in writing vide this office letter dated 01.10.2020.</i> The draft review of mining plan thereafter has not been received by this office.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.

04. You are advised to rectify the violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within a period of 45 (Forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.


