Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 in respect of your **BANDHAL MN MINE** in Sundergarh District of Odisha over an area of 28.027 hectare.

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 (hereinafter referred MCDR, 1988) were found violated in your above said mine during inspection on 20.05.2016 by undersigned accompanied by Sri Chudamani Biswal (Senior Inspector Mine, Koira Circle), Yourself and Mine Official Sri Atmesh Kumar Sharma (Mine Manager).

Rule	Rule position	Status and extent of violation
13(1)	Every holder of a mining lease shall carry out mining operations in accordance with the approved mining plan with such conditions as may have been prescribed under sub-rule (2) of rule 9 or with such modifications, if any, as permitted under rule 10 or the mining plan or scheme approved under rule 11 or 12 as the case may be.	Mining operations have not been carried out in accordance to Scheme of Mining, approved vide this office letter number MS/MAN/36-ORI/BHU/2012-13 dated 09.04.2013 to the extent given below: 1) It was observed that exploration proposed for the year 2015-16 by 13 numbers of boreholes were not carried out.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 58 of MCDR, 1988. Besides, inability to comply the provision of rule 13(1) is also liable for suspension of mining operation under the provision of rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988 respectively.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
