Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 in respect of Gonua Iron & Manganese Mine of Shri Pawan Kumar Ahluwalia, over an area of 86.886 ha in Sundergarh District of Odisha State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 (MCDR'88) were found violated in your above said mine during inspection by Shri N M Dey, Assistant Mining Engineer accompanied by S/Shri S K Jena, DGM (Planning), S K Sahu, Mines Manager & P K Sahu, Surveyor on 25.09.2016.

Rule being violated	Rule position	Status and extent of violation
23 E(2)	The Owner, agent, manager or mining engineer shall submit to the Regional Controller of Mines , a yearly report before 1 st July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reason there of.	Yearly report for the year 2015-16 on protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved Scheme of Mining and Progressive mine closure plan approved vide letter no.MS/FM/45-ORI/BHU/2014-15 dated 31.07.2015 has not been submitted.

02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 58 of MCDR, 1988. The relevant extract of the rule 58 is given below:

“58. Penalty:- Whoever contravenes any of the provisions of these rules shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend up to two years, or with fine extending to fifty thousand rupees or with both, and in case of continuing contravention with an additional fine which may extend up to five thousand rupees for every day during which such contravention continues, after conviction for the first such contravention. Provided that for repeat contravention the punishment should be in the form of imprisonment only”.

03. You are therefore, advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the actions taken by you in this regard to this office within 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
