



**Scrutiny comments on examination of Review Mining Plan of Rain Limestone Mine over an area of 417.95 Ha in Revoor and Mellacheruvu Villages, Mellacheruvu Mandal, Suryapet District, Telangana State submitted under Rule 17 (2) of MCR 2016.**

**General**

1. Company name, mine code, lease period shall be submitted in the cover page.
2. Status of implementation of CCOM Circular no. 2/2010 to be submitted.
3. Excel sheet is submitted without entering/editing the details of your mine and review of mining plan submission.
4. List of annexures and plates submitted for review of mining plan shall be mentioned.
5. The document shall be submitted as per the format mentioned in the FAQ on format of Mining Plans issued vide CCOM Circular 1/2021 dated 08.09.2021.
6. The final document shall adhere the conditions stipulated in CCOM circular No. 01/2021 dated 07.06.2021 & FAQ on format of Mining Plans issued vide CCOM Circular 1/2021 dated 08.09.2021.
7. Color photographs should be enclosed as annexure for easy reference pertaining to boundary pillars, working pit, dump, afforestation, core logs, ground control points etc.
8. Production was not achieved as proposed during the present plan period. Whereas increase in production from 1.5 million tonnes to 3.9 million has been proposed from 3<sup>rd</sup> year of plan period in the review of mining plan submitted. Hence justification for increasing the production capacity from 1.5 million tonnes per annum to 3.9 million tonnes per annum shall be submitted.

Category of Mine shall be submitted correctly.

Initial grant, amalgamation and lease extension copies shall be submitted as annexure.

Type of land is not as per the format.

MP/MMP/RMP approval date shall be mentioned correctly.

Boundary pillar co-ordinates shall be submitted in UTM co-ordinates as annexure.

As mentioned in the Mining Plan format, minutes of Board Resolution in case of Nominated owner shall be submitted.

**1.3.7. Qualified Person details**

As there is no provision for group of qualified persons in MCR-2016, only one qualified persons be nominated to prepare the document.

**2.1.4.3.** Average thickness & grade of the various types of limestone in the lithology units shall be submitted.

**2.1.4.6.** Nature/Form of Mineral shall be mentioned correctly.

**2.2.1.14.** Details of the area covered under exploration shall be submitted correctly.

**2.2.3.** Details of all radicals of limestone shall be submitted in chemical parameters column.

**2.2.4.13.** Reserves/Reserves estimation shall be submitted correctly based on the exploration carried out in the mining lease area.

**2.2.5.** Lessee should carry out detailed exploration (G1 level) over the entire potentially mineralized area under the mining lease within a period of 5 years from the date of commencement of MCDR 2017. Exploration proposal and commitment to complete the exploration shall be submitted accordingly.

Proper justification for deviation in the proposed exploration, development, production, afforestation and environmental protective measures shall be submitted.

#### **Plans & Sections:**

1. Conceptual plan to be prepared for the entire lease area showing UPL, life of the mine, conceptual exploration, pit dimension, land use pattern, status of reclamation and rehabilitation, land use, position of pit, dumps, dump re-handling proposals, green belt development etc. at the end of this 5 year period and at the end of the lease period.
2. Plans and sections shall be submitted in UTM co-ordinates.
