Sub:- Violation of provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rule 2017 in respect of M/s, Tirupati Minerals, over an area of 17.51 Hectares situated near village - Bhimantola Teh- Ramtek, District- Nagpur of Maharashtra State in connection with Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rule, 2017 (MCDR, 2017) were found violated in respect of the above said mine during inspection on 13.09.2021 by A.K. Patel AMG .

Rule	Nature of Violation observed																																
11(1)	<p>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part-B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.
