Subject : Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Naugawan Bauxite Mine over an area of 13.44 hect. in Satna District of M.P.

Sir,
The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 21.09.2021 by Sh. R.S.Garg, Assistant Mining Engineer, accompanied by yourself & R.C.Bansal, Mining Engineer of the mine.

नियम स.	पाए गए उल्लंघन की विस्तृत प्रकृति
Rule 26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof: The yearly report has not been submitted for the year 2020-21.
Rule 31(4)	The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve months in case of any other mine The plans & sections were not found updated on quarterly basis as required under this rule and not maintained at mines site office.
Rule 33	Copies of plans and sections to be submitted – The holder of mining lease shall on or before the 30th day of the June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Govt., a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32. Copies of plans and sections under rule 32 of MCDR-2017 have not been submitted.
Rule 45(7)	If it is found that the holder of a mining lease or the person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, as the case may be, has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in daily or monthly or annual returns or fails to submit a return within the date specified; then, – in the case of mining of minerals by the holder of a mining lease, the Regional Controller of Mines may advise the State Government to, – order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and to revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance; take action to initiate prosecution under these rules; recommend termination of the mining lease, in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining; On examination of Annual Return for the year 2020-21 it is observed that data of annual return are incomplete & having following deficiencies:- Part III , item No. 2, Rent and Royalty It is revealed from the record that both- royalty and dead rent are paid against the same year whereas as per rule only either royalty or dead rent whichever is higher, is chargeable. Necessary corrections need be incorporated. Part III, item No 5 NMET paid to central Govt. is not indicated in the return. Part VI, (Production, Dispatch and stock) and Sales/Dispatches effected for Domestic Consumption and for exports(BAUXITE) As per production and dispatch table 10024.3 tonne Bauxite (6063.5tonne for cement and 7305.0tonne chemical grade) dispatched from the mine whereas as per Sales/Dispatches effected for Domestic Consumption total quantity of bauxite sold indicated as 13368.9tonne(7305.4 tonne Cement grade and 6063.5tonne chemical grade). Reason for the same need be clarified. Part VII, Cost of Production For the calculation of cost of production Rs.40/- per tone amount has been taken against overhead expenses whereas on relevant part of return it is indicated as nil.

**Rule
55 (1)**


For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules, –

- (a) every holder of reconnaissance permit shall employ a whole-time geologist;
- (b) every holder of prospecting licence or a prospecting license-cum-mining lease shall employ a whole-time geologist and a part-time mining engineer;
- (c) every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of–
category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist;
category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist:

Provided that in the case of fully mechanised category 'A' mines, the mining engineers and geologists shall have minimum five years of professional experience of working in a supervisory capacity in the field of mining.


A whole time mining engineer has not been appointed in the mine as per rule.

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
3. In case Non-compliance of Rule 45(7) of MCDR-2017, necessary action shall be initiated as deemed fit.
4. **You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office Within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.**

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were also found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 21.09.2021 by Sh. R.S.Garg, Assistant Mining Engineer, accompanied by yourself & R.C.Bansal, Mining Engineer of the mine. This is in continuation to this office letter of even no. dated 01/10/2021 through which violation of rule 26(2), 31(4), 33, 45(7) & 55(1) were pointed out.

11(1)	<p>Holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.</p> <p>The document of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No.- MP/Satna/Bauxite /RMP-47/2018-19 dated 07/03/2019 incorporating proposal of working from 2019-20 to 2023-24.</p> <p>i) In the year 2020-21 it was proposed to produced 58325 metric tonnes of Bauxite, with removal of 44762CUM overburden/SB/IB. However in the year 2020-21 only 24840 metric tonnes of Bauxite has been produced with removal of 1500CUM overburden/SB/IB. The actual stripping ratio also reduced from proposed one of 1:0.7 to 1:0.6</p> <p>ii) Against the proposal of 16000 plantation for the year 2021 only 3000 plantation have been carried out.</p>

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
3. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory..
4. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office Within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
