Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 in respect of your **CHAMAKPUR IRON ORE MINE** in Keonjhar District of Odisha over an area of 31.693 hectare.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 (hereinafter referred MCDR, 1988) were found violated in your above said mine during inspection on 17.05.2016 by undersigned accompanied by Mine officials Sri B.R Das (Mine Incharge & GM), Sri Sukant Kumar das (Mine Manager) and Sri Dipak Kumar Deo (Mining Engineer).

13(1)	Every holder of a mining lease shall carry out mining operations in accordance with the approved mining plan with such conditions as may have been prescribed under sub-rule (2) of rule 9 or with such modifications, if any, as permitted under rule 10 or the mining plan or scheme approved under rule 11 or 12 as the case may be.	Mining operations have not been carried out in accordance to Scheme of Mining, approved vide this office letter number MPM/OTFM/17-ORI/BHU/2014-15 dated 05.01.2015 to the extent given below: 1) It was observed that exploration proposed during year 2014-15 and 2015-16 by 04 numbers of boreholes for each year were not carried out. 2) Production of 23060.80 Metric Tonnes (MT) and 20300.00 MT for the year 2014-15 and 2015-16 respectively proposed from Old Existing Dump were not carried out. 3) During inspection it is observed that screened Iron Ore of various size and grade have been stacked on non-approved area i.e. Southwest of lucky pit. 4) it is observed that plantation proposed in the year 2015-16 between boundary pillar 18 and 19 in safety zone were not carried out.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 58 of MCDR, 1988. Besides, inability to comply the provision of rule 13(1) is also liable for suspension of mining operation under the provision of rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988 respectively.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter
