Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 1988 (amended up to 2011) in respect of Bururgula Limestone Mine of Shri I.Sri Ramulu, over an extent of 7.48 hect situated (S.No.U.S.H.B.)in Bururgula Villaga Bethamcherla (M), Kurnool district of A.P state

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 1988, were found violated in the above mine during inspection on 17.10.2016 by Shri A.PrabhakaraRao, Assistant Mining Geologist., IBM accompanied by your representative Sri I.Chandrasekhar

Rule	Nature of Violation observed
12(3)	Scheme of Mining for the above mine was approved vide letter No. AP/KNL/MP/L.St-83/HYD dated 03.06.2009 for a period of 2007-2008 to 2011-2012. The validity of approved document expired on 31/03/2012. The scheme of mining for next five years ought to have been submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines, Hyderabad, at least one hundred twenty days before the expiry of five years period for which it was approved on the last occasion which has not been submitted.
13(1)	Every holder of a mining lease shall carry out mining operations in accordance with the approved mining plan with such conditions as may have been prescribed under sub-rule (2) of rule 9 or with such modifications, if any, as permitted under rule 10 or the mining plan or scheme approved under rule 11 or 12 as the case may be. Mining operations should have been undertaken in accordance with the approved Mining Plan/ Scheme of Mining. Since you have no approved document for your above mentioned Mine, it is evident that the Mining Operations are not being carried out in accordance with the approved document.

02. It is brought to your notice that the above said violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule-58 of MCDR, 1988. Besides, inability to comply the provision of Rule 13(1) attracts provisions of Rule 13(2) which are liable for suspension of mining operations under rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988.

03. You are, therefore, directed to **show-cause** within a period of 30(thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be **prosecuted** for the above offence and or Mining operations shall be suspended under the provision of Rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988 in the Mine till the compliance of the aforesaid violation.

04. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
