Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR 1988 in respect of your **Malda Kyanite Mine (Lease Area 2.35 Ha.)** located in village Malda, District-Bhandara of Maharashtra state.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 02.11.2016 carried out by Shri. S.M.Dorle, Astd. Mining Engineer.

Rule No. Nature of violation observed in details

13(1) Every holder of mining lease shall carry out mining operation in accordance with the approved Mining Plan/Scheme with such condition as may have been prescribed under sub rule(2) of rule 9 or with such modification, if any, as permitted under rule 10 or the mining plan or scheme of mining as approved under rule 11 or 12 as the case may be.

The following deviation are observed during inspection-

Boundary pillars have not been erected as per CCOM's circular 2/2010 (addendum) No.11013/3/MP/90-CCOM Vol-VII, dated 23.09.2011

Thus attracting the violation of provision Rule 13 (1) of MCDR, 1988 which may lead to suspension of mining operations in accordance to Rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988.

23(D) The owner, agent, mining engineer, or manager of every mine shall send to the Controller General, Controller of Mines and the Regional Controller under registered cover, a notice in Form-D of his intention to abandon a mine or a part of a mine so as to reach them at least ninety days before the intended date of such abandonment.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 58 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 1988.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter
