Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 1988 in respect of Palkur limestone Mine over an extent of 2.647 h of M/s. Lakshmi Tirumala Minerals Palkur village, Banaganapalle Mandal, Kurnool dist., Andhra Pradesh-Regarding.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 (Amended in 2011) were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 19.8.2016 by Sri M.Pratap Reddy, Assistant Mining Geologist accompanied by Sri Rajashekar Reddy, Partner:

Rule No.	Nature of Violation
13(1)	Mining operations are not being carried out in accordance with the approved Mining Plan vide letter no. AP/KNL/MP/Lst-134/HYD, dated 16.01.2012 with proposal for the period upto 2017-18 which has already been communicated vide this Office letter of even no. dated 21.3.2014 to the extent indicated below: i. Against the proposal of exploration in form of 2 Core drilling boreholes to a depth of 10 mts each and three trial pits with a size of 3X 3X 5 to 8 mts during 1 st year after the lease is granted, no exploration have been done. ii. It was proposed to plant every year 22 saplings at 3 mts grid interval in the southern boundary of the lease area, where as the plantation work has not been taken up.
23E(2)	The yearly report for the year 2015-16 setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitation work as envisaged in the approved Scheme of Mining ought to have been submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines, Hyderabad before First July, 2016 has not been submitted.
24	It was reported that mine workings have been temporarily discontinued but a notice in Form-D1 has not been submitted.
53	Copies of various notices and returns and the different statutory registers have not been maintained at the mines office/have not made available to the inspecting officers of Indian Bureau of Mines.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that non compliance of violation of Rule 13(1) attract the provisions of Rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988.

03. You are, therefore, directed to **show cause** within a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence or mining operations suspended under Rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988.

04. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard
