Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 1988 in respect of Muddavaram Iron ore mine of M/s NSL Mining Resources, over an area of 6.2 ha in Muddavaram Village, in Kurnool District, A.P. State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 (amended in 2011) were found violated in the above mine during the inspection on 16-10-2016 by Sri P. Guruvaiah, Asst. Mining Geologist of this office in the presence of mine official; Sri R.Chandrasekhar Reddy, Mine Representative.

Rule No.	Nature of violation observed
12(3)	The Scheme of Mining for your Muddavaram Iron Ore Mine was approved on
	08.04.2011 for the period from 2011-12 to 2015-16, which expired on 31.03.2016. The
	Scheme of Mining for next five years ought to have been submitted to the Regional
	Controller of Mines, Indian Bureau of Mines, Hyderabad for subsequent periods, at
	least 120 days before the expiry of five years period for which the scheme of mining
	approved on the last occasion and the same has not been submitted so far.
13(1)	Mining operations should have been undertaken in accordance with the approved
	Mining Plan/Scheme of Mining. Since you have no approved Scheme of Mining for
	your above mentioned mine, it is evident that the mining operations are not being
	carried out in accordance with the approved Scheme of Mining.
24	It was reported that mine working have been temporarily discontinued but notice in
	form D1 has not been submitted.

- 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above said violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule-58 of MCDR, 1988.
- 03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 13(2) if compliance of Rule 13(1) through 12(3) found not satisfactory.
- 04. You are, therefore, directed to **show cause** within a period of 30 (thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence or mining operations suspended under Rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988.
- 05. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
