Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 in respect of your Kulum Iron Ore Mines over an area of 33.803 hectare in Keonjhar District of Odisha State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 1988 (hereinafter referred MCDR, 1988) were found violated in your above said mine during inspection on 03.08.2015 by undersigned accompanied by Shri Majhi (surveyor) and Shri C.R. Mahapatra (RQP).

Rule	Rule position	Status and extent of violation
13(1)	Every holder of a mining lease shall carry out mining operations in accordance with the approved mining plan with such conditions as may have been prescribed under sub-rule (2) of rule 9 or with such modifications, if any, as permitted under rule 10 or the mining plan or scheme approved under rule 11 or 12 as the case may be.	Mining operations have not been carried out in accordance to Modification of approved Mining Plan, approved on dated 30.01.2015 to the extent given below: 1) It was observed that exploration proposed during year 2014-15 by 08 numbers of boreholes were not carried out.
47(a)	Notice of shaft sinking and boreholes:- The owner, agent, mining engineer, geologist.....the sinking of trial shaft or borehole to a depth exceeding ten metres from the surface.	1) During inspection it is observed that in year 2013-14, a total of 08 exploratory boreholes were drilled having depth more than ten meter. However, form J as required under rule was not submitted to Controller General, Controller of Mines and Regional controller of Mines, Bhubaneshwar till date.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 58 of MCDR, 1988. Besides, inability to comply the provision of rule 13(1) is also liable for suspension of mining operation under the provision of rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988 respectively.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter
