NOTICE

As per the provisions of Rule 45 of MCDR'2017, for Registration of all stakeholders and filing of statutory returns pertaining to the field of mining, there are two available systems: Mining Tenement System portal (mitra.ibm.gov.in) and NIC portal (ibmreg.nic.in and ibmreturns.gov.in). Indian Bureau of Mines is in process of transition from existing modules and portals available for Registration and Return (namely MTS Portal) to new portals being developed by NIC for the purpose. To facilitate the transition, records of registration and returns need to be available over existing NIC portal.

Therefore, following decisions are taken in respect of category of users enlisted below:-

- A. For existing MTS (MITRA) portal Users who are already registered in existing NIC portal:
- (i) No return shall be submitted or accepted over MTS (MITRA) portal. All the returns shall be submitted only over NIC portal 21.05.2021 onwards.
 - (ii) Any correction/updation required in the Registration details (Form K) shall be done over NIC portal only.
 - (iii) All the returns shall be kept up to date over NIC portal for smooth transition to new portals being developed by NIC.
- B. For existing MTS (MITRA) portal Users who are not registered in existing NIC portal:
- (i) Such users shall make Registration application over NIC portal immediately. Concerned Regional Office shall examine the details and approve the Registration record that will be considered to be valid from the date of registration over MTS (MITRA) portal.
 - (ii) Henceforth, no return shall be filed over MTS (MITRA) portal.



C. For new users/ users for whom grant of Registration is pending over MTS (MITRA) portal:

- (i) Such users shall re-apply over existing NIC portal for grant of registration.

As per the aforementioned directions, any activity pertaining to grant of registration shall be treated as "Invalid" and any return submitted shall be treated as "Not Submitted" over MTS (MITRA) portal with immediate effect. In case of any difficulty arising on the part of any stakeholder, concerned Regional Controller of Mines / OIC may be contacted for clarification and guidance.
