Sub: Violation of Provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Nandavaram Limestone Mine over an extent of 4.048 ha., in Nandavaram Village Banaganapalli Mandal Kurnool district of Andhra Pradesh State - reg.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 (MCDR, 2017) were found violated in the above mine during the MCDR inspection by D.P. RAYLKUMAR, AMG on 18.05.2023 accompanying with Shri P.R.Praveen Kumar Reddy, lessee's representative.

| 11 (1)   | <p>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining Operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the Sate Government pursuant to proviso to clause(b) of sub-section (2) of section 5.</p> <p>Mining operation were not being carried out in accordance with the proposals given in approved Review of Mining Plan vide letter No. AP/KNL/MP/LST-191/HYD dated 09.05.2022 and following deviations have been observed:</p> <p>(i) It was proposed to drill 5 bore holes with total meterage of 75 m during the year 2022-23 whereas nil exploration was carried out sofar.</p> <p>(ii) It was proposed to plant 25 numbers of saplings during the year 2022-23 whereas nil plantation has been during the year 2022-23.</p> |
| 26 (2)   | <p>The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1<sup>st</sup> day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof:</p> <p>During the inspection, it is observed that yearly report setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan is not submitted to Regional Controller of Mines for the year 2021-22.</p>   |


