Sir,

Following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your mine during the scrutiny of office records & during inspection dt.08.11.22:

11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government.
	The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter NoMP/Balaghat/Manganese/RMP-09/2021-22 dated 30/07/2021 incorporating proposal of working from 2021-22 to 2025-26.
	 (a) Exploration was not done against proposal of 26 exploratory bore holes for the year 2021-22. (b) Only 1358 T of ROM achieved against the proposal of 4020 T for the year 2021-22. (c) Only 1980m3 of waste reported against the proposal of 3449 m3 of waste generation for the year 2021-22.
33	Copies of plans and sections to be submitted - The holder of mining lease shall on or before the
	30th day of the June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Govt. a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32.
	Copies of updated plans and sections under rule 32 of MCDR-2017 have not been submitted.

- 1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- 2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
- 3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
