
The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by undersigned on 26.09.22 in presence of Shri Jawahar Lal Sharaf, Mining Engineer and Shri. Vidya Sagar Sahu, Qualified Person detailed as below -:

Rule 11 (1)	<p><i>According to this rule-No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Govt. pursuant to the provisions to clause (b) of Sub Section (2) of Section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for exploration and Researching respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule of the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limit declared under schedule-A of the Atomic Mineral Concession Rules 2016</i></p> <p>i) The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No-MP/Katni/Limestone/RMP-13/2019-20 dated 09.08.2019. As per the para 1(i) of Geology &amp; exploration chapter under the future exploration programme, total 04 boreholes were proposed during the year 2019-20, but, in respect of this proposal only 03 core boreholes have been drilled.</p> <p>ii) As per Para-a of chapter-4, during approved plan period from 2019-20 to 2022-23, total 55929 M3 overburden generation and its disposal over mined area in 7.5m barrier zone &amp; in Pit-2 was proposed for backfilling purpose. But, during inspection, it was observed that the overburden/waste material was dumped beyond the UPL i.e. within the 7.5m barrier zone and also crosses beyond ML boundary at north &amp; south eastern part of the area.</p> <p>iii) As per Para-a of chapter-4, during approved plan period from 2019-20 to 2022-23, total 55929 M3 overburden generation and its disposal over mined area in 7.5m barrier zone and also over mined out area in southern part of Pit-2 was proposed. But, backfilling was also carried out in Pit-1 which was not proposed &amp; in contradiction with approved proposals.</p>
Rule 26(2)	<p><i>The holder of mining lease shall submit a yearly report as per the format specified before 1<sup>st</sup> July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative work carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reason thereof</i></p> <p>Aforesaid report in prescribe Form for the year 2021-22 was not submitted to the Regional Controller of Mine, Jabalpur till the date of inspection.</p>
Rule 31(4)	<p><i>The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve months in case of any other mine</i></p> <p>As this is "A" category mine and required plans &amp; sections are need to be updated on quarterly basis as required under this rule but the same were are not updated in stipulated time and not maintained at mines site office.</p>



02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.
03. Non-compliance of the rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 may lead to suspension of Mining operations under the provisions of rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017.
04. You are therefore advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
05. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.




