
महोदय,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by undersigned along with Shri M. Sabre, SMG on 13.04.2022 in presence of Shri Akhil Pandey, Lessee's representative, Shri. Sourabh Nayak, Mines Manager & Shri Umakant Soni, Geologist are detailed as below :-

Rule 11(1)	<p>According to this rule-No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Govt. pursuant to the provisions to clause (b) of Sub Section (2) of Section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for exploration and Researching respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule of the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limit declared under schedule-A of the Atomic Mineral Concession Rules 2016 /</p> <p>1. The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No-MP/Katni/Bauxite/RMP-50/2017-18 dated 29.05.2017 for the 5 yrs proposal period from 2017-18 to 2021-22. As per the para 2(b) of Mining chapter, during the year 2020-21 & 2021-22 total 20910 CuM & 21120 CuM of overburden were proposed to be generated. But, against to these proposals, only 15 Cum OB generated in 2020-21 & 2960 CuM overburden generated in the year 2021-22. Thus, there are significant deviations in approved proposals during the years 2020-21 & 2021-22.</p> <p>2. Further, as per the para 2(b) of Mining chapter, during the year 2020-21 total 91287 tonne & during the 2021-22 total 90258 tonnes of bauxite ore production were proposed against to these proposals only 253.89 tonnes in 2020-21 & 66,565 tonnes bauxite ore production achieved in 2021-22. Thus, there are significant deviations in approved proposals for the year 2020-21 & 2021-22.</p>
Rule 26(2)	<p>The holder of mining lease shall submit a yearly report as per the format specified before 1st July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative work carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reason thereof</p> <p>Aforesaid report in prescribe Form for the year 2020-21 not submitted to the Regional Controller of Mine, Jabalpur till the date of inspection.</p>
Rule 54(a)	<p>The holder of a mining lease or a holder of a prospecting licence or prospecting license-cum-mining lease shall maintain the labour attendance register, production and dispatch register, royalty assessment register, etc.-</p> <p>But, during inspection, it is observed that you have not maintained documents pertaining to the production of different grades of bauxite ore & laterite ore, inventory of dispatched ore, details of contribution made to District Mineral Foundation and National Mineral exploration Trust, etc as required under this rule.</p>

1. In response to violation letter dated 13/06/2022, your reply vide letter No. Nil dt- Nil was received on 19/10/2022 in which rectifications of violations done under rules 11(1), 26(2) & 54(a) were found unsatisfactory and incomplete manner. Therefore, violation of Rule 11(1), 26(2) & 54(a) still exist in above mentioned mine.
2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
3. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 are not found satisfactory.
4. You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offences.
5. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.


