Sub. : Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of your Chandan Limestone Mine over an area of 7.205 hect. in Katni District of M.P.


Sir,

Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection by the Undersigned on 28/04/2022 in the presence of Shri. Indraneel Dawande (Qualified person), Shri Aditya Bagadia (Lessee's son), Shri. Mritunjay Prasad (Mining Engineer) & mines officials:

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• It was proposed to carry out development cum production be from MRL 397-392m & 392-388m during the year 2021-22. But the depthwise development was lagging & the benches were developed upto 404 mRL only.• Only 10800 tonnes ROM is produced against the proposal of 89524 tonnes for the year 2021-22.• It was proposed to carryout afforestation in the backfilled area between the grid coordinates N (2623430 to 2623610) & E (452990 to 453090) near the boundary pillar No.6 to 5 & 19 to 20 for the year 2021-22 but the same has not been carried out.• The boundary pillars were not erected as per rule.
34 A (3)	Every lessee shall carry out a drone survey of his leased area and upto hundred metres outside the lease boundary within six months before submission of any mining plan document or modification thereto to the Indian Bureau of Mines for approval and shall submit processed output [digital elevation model (DEM) and Orthomosaic] images obtained from such survey or any other format as may be specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines in this regard to the concerned Regional Controller of Mines and the Controller General along with the application for approval of mining plan: (DEM) and Orthomosaic images obtained from drone survey was not submitted during the application of the mining plan.

1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
