Subject: - Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 of your Sejha Limestone Mine, Mine code - 38MPR47075 over an Area 6.552 ha in District Katni.

Sir,

Following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your mine during the examination of drone image submitted to this office dt. 17/02/2023 & inspection in your presence and mines officials dt.18.10.22:

Rule	Nature of violation observed in detail
No 11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in
	accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government. The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No MP/ Katni /Limestone/RMP-04/2018-19 dated 22/06/2018 incorporating proposal of working from 2018-19 to 2022-23 and following deviations have been observed:
	 (a) On the examination of drone image and during inspection it was observed that the lease boundary was breached near the boundary pillars BP-10, BP-11, BP-12 & from BP-26, BP-27, BP-28, BP-29. Also stocks were kept outside the lease area near the boundary pillars BP-4, BP-5, BP-6, and BP-7 & from BP-8, BP-9, BP-10. (b) 17800 T of ROM (Limestone) achieved against the proposal of 26523 T ROM (Limestone)
	for the year 2021-22.
	(c) Nil waste generated against the proposal of 1516 m3 t of waste generation for the year 2021-22.
	(d) Nil topsoil generated against the proposal of 1546 m3 t of waste generation for the year 2021-22.
34A(3)	Every lessee shall carry out a drone survey of his leased area and upto hundred metres outside the lease boundary within six months before submission of any mining plan document or modification thereto to the Indian Bureau of Mines for approval and shall submit processed output [digital elevation model (DEM) and Orthomosaic] images obtained from such survey or any other format as may be specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines in this regard to the concerned Regional Controller of Mines and the Controller.
	Drone survey data is submitted, but SOP is not followed. Shape file in polygons for all the requisite heads for existing & future proposals not submitted.
45(7)	The following deficiencies were observed in the Annual Returns submitted for the year 2021-22: i. In Part-I, Sl.No.12, the lease area (surface area) utilisation are furnished incorrectly.
	ii. Part – V, Reserves and Resources estimated at the end of the year for Limestone is incorrectly submitted.
	iii. Part – V, Details of Benches is incorrectly submitted.
	 iv. Part – V, under Sec 5, the details of machinery provided is incomplete. v. Part -VII In the cost per tonne calculation, the details of DMF and NMET are not included.
	v. Part -VII In the cost per tonne calculation, the details of DMF and NMET are not included.

- 1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- 2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) & 45(7) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) & 45(7) of MCDR-2017 read with MCDR-2021 (Amendment) is not found satisfactory.
- 3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
