<b>11 (1)</b>	As per the approved Review of mining plan dated 31.03.2020 i) It is proposed to produce 1399582 t quantity of limestone mineral during the year 2022-23. ii) It is proposed to submit the Geo-referenced cadastral map prepared as per the CCOM Circular No.2/2010 as per the undertaking given in the approved mining plan.	i) During inspection it is observed the production of limestone quantity is 784701 t for the year 2022-23 which is deviation (44%) from the approved mining plan proposal. ii) Till date the Geo-referenced cadastral map prepared as per the CCOM Circular No.2/2010 is not submitted, which is mandatory to comply the CCOM Circular No.2/2010 as well as to carry out drone survey as per rule 34(A) of MCDR, 2017.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the violation of aforesaid rule constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 62(1) of MCDR, 2017.

03. The mining operations can also be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.

04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
