**Subject:-** Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of Jamli Choti Arand falia Manganese Mine, over an area of 15.26 hectare in Alirajpur district of M.P. State.

Sir,

Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of your representative Shri S.K Jhoshi ,Shri H Kranthi (Mine Manger), Shri Dipesh Solanki (Geologist), and other mines officials on 21/11/2022. Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection.

<b>11(1)of MCDR 2017</b>	<p>1. Mining operations under mining lease.–(1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.</p> <p>The document of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No.-MP/Alirajpur/Manganese/RMP-41/2019-20 dated 04/08/2020 incorporating proposal of working from 2020-21 to 2022-23</p> <p>During inspection it has been observed that the following provisions of the rule have been violated: -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Only 6222.210 tonnes of Manganese ore production is raised during 2021-22 against the proposed 15008 tonnes.</li> <li>2. It was proposed to produce 18488 m<sup>3</sup> of Overburden during 2021-22 but only 2700 m<sup>3</sup> is produced.</li> <li>3. It was proposed to drill 26 core boreholes but not a single core bore hole is drilled.</li> <li>4. Pits were not developed as per proposals</li> <li>5. Pitting is in 7.5 m barrier and outside the lease boundary between BP 31 and BP 30</li> <li>6. Plantation has not been done.</li> </ol>
<b>34A</b>	<p><b>Submission of Drone survey data .</b> – 1. Drone survey data is submitted, but SOP is not followed, Shape file of lease boundary, GCP's , existing pit, dump, top soil dumping area, plantation etc is not submitted. Shape file in polygons for above mentioned heads for future proposals may also be submitted.</p> <p>2. Ground control points are not constructed.</p>

- 1 In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
3. You are advised to rectify the violations of above mentioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
