Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Roshra Bauxite Mine (16.188 Ha) of M/s Hukumchand Stone Lime Company in Jabalpur district of M.P.

Sir.

Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of re-presentative of lessee, Mines officials and QP on 17/06/2022. Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection.

	(c) Extension of pit/ benches was extended beyond the 7.5-meter statutory barrier zone			
	near BP 3, BP no. 4 etc which is also shown in the surface plan.			
	(d) Mining operations (Stacking) is noticed outside M.L boundary between Boundary pillar no. 2 and 3.

As per MCDR(Amendment), 2021 notified on 3<sup>rd</sup>November, 2021;Rupees 500000/-is to be paid for non appointment of Geologist and mining engineer for violating the Rule 55, as specified in schedule III.

Thus you shall be liable to pay an amount of Rs 5,00,000/- in case the violation is not rectified within stipulated time.

In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.

The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.

You are advised to rectify the violations of above mentioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
